**Middle Lake Bird Hide and Reedy Lake Sanctuary – Kerang**

The sanctuary is free entry and has an elevated viewing hide open at all times. This is the perfect position to view the magnificent birdlife including: Straw Necked White Ibis, Pelicans, Swans, Spoonbills, Egrets and Ducks. The best viewing time is dawn and dusk when thousands of ibis and other birdlife leave or return to their nests. This is well worth a visit.
